Crack's dam Biserta brought many approved stallions, for example with Cor de la Bryere Calvados I, II and III.

Cosy Z's dam My Setsu xx was a true exception in every view. Being out of very old and valuable Thoroughbred lines, this mare had a very successful racing career herself. Still absolutely sound she started her breeding career with 11 years and got Cosy Z as her 12th foal in the age of 24.

This very valuable Thoroughbred line on the bottom makes Lilac Z to a very interesting speciality.

Alexis Z gained his international reputation not only through his own show career, but especially through such successful offspring as Amaretto I and II and Apricot B.

Sire **Alternative Z**'s sire **Alexis Z** is the most successful producing Alme - descendant and the most important representative of the Alme - line right now. He proved himself in the top sport with lots of Grand Prix wins and placements and followed with that the tradition of his dam "Wonne", which had a very successful and convincing sportcareer, too. Famous examples of his offspring like Apricot D, Amaretto D and many more brought him the nickname "Landgraf of the south" and made his owner (Drachenhof / Rombelsheim) to one of the most successful breeders of Germany.

Dam **Rascal Z** represents one of the most famous families worldwide. She is a standard example of the successful connection Ramiro - Alme - Gotthard and in every view the perfect stallion-mother.
